

## Hat Island Marina Parking

Parking on community property is not a right, but a privilege. The rules, below, will be enforced to prevent the expansion of the parking areas at the marina.

All cars must have a lot number visible on either the rear bumper, rear window, or trunk before they will be loaded on the Elsie M for delivery to Hat Island. Two-inch high decals or something as easy to read must be used to identify the lot number on the vehicle. The numbers cannot be made of electrical tape and other non-permanent materials.

A photo copy of the title is to be given to the Elsie M captain at the time of loading or if the office is open they can make a copy for the island records.

Autos and trucks are limited to any combinations of two (2) per voting owner member on the island. This limitation does not apply to commercially operated vehicles. Only one (1) vehicle at a time may be parked in the marina, per lot.

Boats and boat trailers must have permission to park in the lots and the same parking fee applies.

Day-Only parking area restrictions of 24 hour parking will be enforced.

Park in designated areas, not in inappropriate areas such as the road leading to the Elsie M. ramp, below the clubhouse inside the logs, or in the picnic area. Any car parked inappropriately will be moved at the owner's expense.

It is the owner's responsibility to notify the office when a car is sold.

In summation, your vehicles must be properly identified, must be registered, must not be parked in unauthorized areas, or they may be impounded by either moving to storage on the island or hauled off the island at the owner's expense and disposed of, in accordance with laws governing abandoned or illegally parked vehicles.

Violators of these regulation will be fined \$10 per violation, which must be paid within 30 days of the date of violation notice, whereupon, if the violation is not paid, additional fees will be issued.
