Below are the results from the Survey mailed out with the last ballot. Some questions have been marked out because they require too much space to show every answer. Please remember when reviewing this survey that not all people answered all questions, and many questions were left blank.

The Total Number of Surveys Received was 201. Question # 18 has been ruled invalid since the actual cost of an additional water system would be in the neighborhood of \$300, not \$900. Of the 187 surveys that answered Question #1, the average family size was 2.8 people. The median size of the family was 1.95.
