

COVID-19 Ferry Policy (updated 5/20/2020)

Starting Thursday, May 21, 2020 the Hat Express ferry will only be providing ferry service to Hat Island owners, their spouse or partner and dependent children, adult children, grandparents, grandchildren and siblings as well as other dependent relatives living in the household until further notice.

The ferry will be limited to 40 passengers per crossing.

Please pay attention to the website, Hat Island Info page on Facebook and Twitter for any ferry changes.

This policy is in effect for all ferry runs. Should at any time we have a large number of owners waiting for passage to or from the island the Captain, with input from Island management, will make a determination on an any additional runs.

The ferry crew will direct owners on seating arrangements.

We ask that all owners be respectful of the ferry crew's direction and comply with their requests.

Island management reserves the right make an exception to this policy in emergency situations.

This policy is consistent with efforts set forth by Governor Inslee and other public officials in an effort to flatten the curve and fight the spread of COVID-19.
