

Hat Island Golf Committee Charter

I. Function

The Golf Committee serves as an advisory committee to the Hat Island Board of Directors.

The Hat Island Community (HIC) shall provide and maintain a private 9-hole golf course facility for the use and enjoyment of HIC members and guests. This policy describes the golf course management responsibilities, the various levels of participation or membership, the rules and regulations for use of the facility and any special consideration for tournaments and group outings.

Fees for use of the golf course, shall be set annually by the HIC Board of Directors during development of the Association's budget, and shall be published in the Association's schedule of dues, assessments, charges and fees. The HIC Manager is authorized to adjust these fees on a temporary basis, should business conditions warrant. No person shall make use of the golf course without prior payment of all applicable fees.

The Golf Committee shall work with the HIC Board, management, and greens-keeper to recommend the annual budget, golf course projects, and recruit and organize volunteers.

II. Authority

This committee draws its authority from the Bylaws and CC&R's, that provide for appointment of committees by the Board of Directors.

III. Appointment

This is a standing committee. The HIC Board of Director's President will appoint the chairman of the committee.
